

Will Tehran Resume Negotiations With Moscow For Proceeding Uranium?

Notwithstanding the pressure of the international community and the probable Iranian-Russian negotiations, according to preliminary information, the Iranian side decided to stop the negotiations with Moscow for proceeding uranium. But, according to the press secretary of the Iranian President, Iran delayed the negotiations for proceeding uranium in the territory of Russia for an uncertain period. It's noteworthy that the negotiations were to be resumed on February 16, but the negotiations were delayed.

On the other hand, RFE/RL informed that the foreign diplomats sated in Baku that Azerbaijan is the military partner of the USA and Israel. They also added that Baku could play an important part in hindering the implementation of Iran's nuclear projects. Moreover, the American officials stated that Azerbaijan can take advantage of the fact that 20 millions of Azerbaijanis live in northern Iran. Besides, one of the American officials stated that the Azerbaijanis of Iran could lead a revolution and carry out power shift.

He added that the territory of Azerbaijan could be used for this purpose, as well as in the cases of attacking the nuclear reactors of Iran.

It's worth reminding that Ilham Aliyev, president of Azerbaijan, stated that he will not allow the USA to use the territory of his country for attacking Iran.
