
Armenian Trade Minister Introduces New Director Of Armenian Development Agency To Staff Of Agency

YEREVAN, September 13. /ARKA/. Armenian Minister of Trade and Economic Development Nerses Yeritsian introduced the newly appointed Director of the Armenian Development Agency (ADA) Tigran Davtian to the staff of the Agency.
