
60 Armenian Organizations And Enterprises To Participate In Armtech 2007

YEREVAN, JUNE 29, NOYAN TAPAN. Representatives of 50 organizations, including universities preparing IT specialists, will participate in the first all-Armenian high-tech congress-exhibition "ArmTech 2007" to be held in Silicon Valley on July 4-7 (www.armtechcongress.com).
